7. CANADIAN HERALDIC AUTHORITY – SHOULDER FLASH

Inspector Bryant introduced Staff Sergeant Underwood and Constable Walker to start the conversation with the Canadian Heraldic Authority on shoulder flash update. The Committee for Indigenous and Cultural Awareness and Education recommended to seek change as an important step towards inclusivity of the indigenous communities of the District of Saanich. The Committee is seeking approval from the Board to begin the process, which can take up to three years.

Approximate costs:

- o \$3,000 \$5,000 for initial process to create coat of arms
- o \$15,000 cost for replacing shoulder flashes
- o \$15,000 cost for new badges for all members
- \$ 3,000 costs for door badges.

MOVED by Ms. Collins and SECONDED by Mr. CRAWFORD: "That the Saanich Police Board approve the Committee for Indigenous and Cultural Awareness and Education to proceed with the initial process through the Canadian Heraldic Authority to update the Saanich Police shoulder flash".
